Matrimony: Preparation must begin six months prior to the wedding date. For more information regarding marriage, contact our pastor.


Anointing of the Sick: Those wishing to receive Holy Communion or to have a priest visit them for the Anointing of the Sick can contact the parish office.


Funerals: In the event of a death and you need to arrange for a funeral, please call the parish office. Call the emergency line if the emergency occurs at a time when the office is not open.
